We are looking for students to serve in Myrtle Beach as summer missionaries for 10 weeks of summer. Our missionaries will have the chance to lead mission teams arriving every week and assist them with day camps in campgrounds and low income housing projects sharing Christ with tourists and locals.

Additional Details

Our summer missionaries come with a wide variety of spiritual gifts. We will place missionary staff in roles leading music and worship, working with international students, sports, day camp, and assisting our mission teams to have a successful week of missions. Whatever your gift, you can be used to share the Great news of Christ in Myrtle Beach.

What type of student is needed?

We are looking for students who have a passion for any of these areas of interests: children, international students, an ability to sing or play an instrument, video or media experience, but most of all a desire to serve and learn. If you have the ability to speak an Asian language, this would be a great asset for our international ministry.

What do you plan to do to mentor the student volunteers spiritually?

To begin our summer, we spend the first 10 days when students arrive training them how to work within our ministry and to completely understand our objectives. Each week, we will meet with our summer missionaries to check in and offer accountability with them to assure they are growing and being challenged. Goals will be set and measured throughout the summer in our weekly meetings.
