Project Description

Brief Project Description

Come to beautiful Lake Tahoe, California, and help children and their parents hear about Jesus. 85% of the people who live in California do not know Jesus. Our children's preschool and school age ministries reach out to the local and tourist children and families with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Additional Details

We are licensed by the State of California Department of Social Services. You must love children. This is a children's ministry position. We want to have a long term relationships with the families and their children. We start with My Morning Out, then transition them into Preschool, School Age, and then youth group. Every day in each age group we teach a Bible story and have prayer time. We are open M-F from 7:30-5:30. Students will work 8:30-5:30. In preschool, you can have up to 12 students with a qualified teacher. In school age you can have up to 14 children per teacher. Our goal is to "Train up a child in the way they should go." We use 28 college students per year. We use 8 students each fall semester, and 8 students each spring semester. In the summer we need 12 students (4 preschool teachers and 8 school age teachers). Students for the school age in the summer are provided by TN, GA, MS, and LA Baptist Campus Ministries. This past month a Mom is bringing her three children every Sunday

to church. Her 8 year old is asking about Jesus. The Mom and the girl are learning more about Jesus.

What type of student is needed?

We are looking for students who love children, who are teachable, and love Jesus.

School age teachers: Need 12 semester hours TOTAL in any combination:-- Education classes, Physical Education, Recreation, Music, Art,

Dance, Theatre, Band, Psychology, Sociology, or Nursing. School age teachers teach their own class. There are 3 age groups: Kindergarten, 1st - 2nd, and 3rd - 6th. Four school age teachers are needed each semester (fall or spring); eight school age teachers are needed for the summer term.

• Preschool age teachers: Need 12 semester hours TOTAL in any combination: Early Childhood Education, Human Growth and Development, Child Life, or Child Development. There are two age groups: Busy Bee Class (2.5 - 3 year olds) and Friendly Frogs Class (4 - 5 year olds). There will be two teachers in each class. Four preschool teachers are needed each semester and summer.

What do you plan to do to mentor the student volunteers spiritually?

A supervisor will send you a devotion each day via email.

We have weekly staff meetings where we grow spiritually.

We have conferences individually with the students twice a month.

Pastor Scott leads a devotion each Sunday before church.

We also have a men's Bible student and a ladies Bible study each week.

Monday through Friday 8:30-5:30--work with children. You will have a 30 minute lunch break and a fifteen minute break either in the morning or the afternoon.

Except for Tuesdays when we have a short staff meetings your evenings are free.

Saturday is your full day off.

Sunday after church is your day off. (Afternoons and evenings off)

We have two dorm rooms. One sleeps 8 people and the other one sleeps 4 people. You will live at the church. We have 4 showers, 9 toilets, washer and dryer, commercial kitchen, wireless internet, etc.

What are meal/food arrangements?

Students will be given money to buy and fix their own food

What are local transportation arrangements?

We have two seven passenger vans. Students may drive them if they have a clean driving record for 3 years. If you are driving them for ministry, we pay for the gas. If it is personal trip, you pay for the gas costs.

Students are allowed to babysit, clean houses, etc. on their free time. It is easy to make money here. The students we get are some of the only people in their age group not doing drugs and alcohol. As long as it does not interfere with the ministries commitments above.

For the spring and fall semesters we provide: housing, food money, RT airfare, and \$500 a month stipend.

In the summer, we pay the above amount for the preschool teachers only. The others come through BCM's in MS, TN, LA, and GA.
