Project Description**Brief Project Description**

Come to Tahoe City, California and experience the beauty of God's creation. You will see also see God's beauty in the children and families of our community. 85% of Californians do not know Jesus. Our goal is to raise a generation of children and their parents to know and love Jesus.

Additional Details

Lake Tahoe is beautiful and has 12 million visitors each year. The lake is 72 miles around and 11 mile across. You will be on the North Shore of the lake. The beach is 1/2 a mile from the church. You will minister to mostly local children. We do have some tourist children who come as well.

This is a children's ministry position for preschool and school age children. You will be assigned to a specific class for the whole summer. Each class will have two teachers. We will provide the materials you need to teach your class. You will teach Bible stories, crafts, fun activities, recreation, etc. Lesson plans will already be prepared for you. If we are out of covid-19 by next summer, we take each group of children on a fun field trip once a week. Because field trips are fun, we get more children who hear the gospel. This ministry started in 1980. We also want to invest in you and help you to know that God can use you!

What type of student is needed?

Preschool classes--These children are toilet trained and are 2.5 years of age-5 years of age. We are licensed by the state of CA, Department of Social Services. To qualify for as a preschool teacher you would need to have completed before arriving 12 semester hours in ANY Combination of: Human Development and Family Studies, Early Childhood Education, Child Life, or classes that deal with the development of children and families. Some psychology classes that deal with growth and development count as well.

School Age classes--We have a TK, K, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd-6th classes. These children are going into Transitional Kindergarten all the way through 6th grade. To qualify as a school age teacher you would need to complete at 12 semester hours in any combination of the following types of classes: Education, psychology, sociology, nursing, home economics, recreation, physical education, music, or early childhood education,

How will you mentor the student spiritually?

Debbie will email each student a devotion each day via email. We have prayer and prayer requests before we begin each day. Personal devotion times as encouraged. We have some staff worship nights. Debbie also meets with each student individually at least twice during the summer to help the grown spiritually and in other ways. We will also train students to deal with conflict in a

biblical way. We have several classes in orientation that will help with their spiritual development.

What training/orientation will you provide for the student?

They will arrive on Tuesday and will have an orientation on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. They will have a variety of types of sessions each day. We have a whole group time as well as different times for preschool and school age training. We will also do a session on classroom management with a local teacher leading this seminar. We have a therapist come in and do the Myers Briggs and dealing with anxiety. The orientation schedule is listed out moment by moment.

Covid-19 schedule starts at 7:30 am and finishes at 5:00 each day The children are here from 8-5, Monday through Friday. We had to allow a little time to disinfect and have prayer time in the mornings. We do our children's ministries Monday-Friday.

They have evenings and all day Saturday off. We have church on Sunday mornings. They may be on the greeting team, bulletins, etc. They will have Sunday afternoon and evening off.

The other 4 students will be preschool teachers recruited from a variety of colleges.

Living Arrangements:

What are housing/lodging arrangements?

We have two dorm rooms. We have 4 sets of bunk beds in one room so that room sleeps 8 females. The other room has two sets of bunk beds and can sleep 4 females. We have capacity for 12 students. We have 9 toilets, 4 showers, commercial kitchen, washer/dryer, pantry, dishwashers, internet and phone reception. We provide all bedding, and towels. ,

What are meal/food arrangements?

The first week they are here, we will prepare meals for them. After that they buy and prepare their own food. We provide \$125 a month for each student for food money. 12 students x 125 a month equals \$1,500 a month for groceries. We provide laundry soap, dryer sheets, toilet paper, paper towels, etc. They only need to buy food. They usually make a grocery list and purchase in bulk.

What are local transportation arrangements?

We have two 7 passenger Toyota Siennas. Students can drive if they are over 21 and have 3 years of a good driving history. There are always 2-4 people who can meet our insurance requirements. We live 1/2 mile from downtown Tahoe City and Lake Tahoe. We have 6 bicycles and a free local transit bus called TART.

Costs

Please include all costs volunteers will need to cover. This might include: housing, meals, local transportation, utilities, internet, phone, etc.

Volunteer Living Expenses:

We provide housing, food, and a \$500 a month stipend for each student. The state convention needs to provide airfare, and insurance. Or the student can have their own insurance.

Ministry Expenses:

We used to be able to provide all gas Now we provide gas for ministry related travel. They pay for their own gas. It is about .30 a mile. But since the vans hold 7 people their cost isn't that much. Probably \$15-20 a month. Everything here is close.

Additional Costs:

They are paid the \$500 a month at the end of each month. It is up to them to decide what they are going to spend money on.
